Below are the profiles of our speakers:

Professor Alan Lau is the Professor of Pharmacy Practice and Director of International Clinical Pharmacy Education at the University of Illinois at Chicago (UIC) College of Pharmacy. During his career, Dr. Lau pioneered the development of clinical pharmacy services for renal failure patients on dialysis. He was also one of the founding members of the Nephrology Practice and Research Network of the American College of Clinical Pharmacy (ACCP) and served on the board of directors and as chairman of the renal scientific section in the American Society for Clinical Pharmacology and Therapeutics.

Dr Nancy L. Shapiro is the Clinical Associate Professor in the Department of Pharmacy Practice, University of Illinois at Chicago (UIC) College of Pharmacy. Dr Shapiro received a Bachelor of Science in Pharmacy in 1993 and Doctor of Pharmacy in 1995, both from the University of Iowa. Her clinical practice site is in the Antithrombosis Clinic at the University of Illinois Outpatient Care Center, where she serves as Operations Manager and Clinical Pharmacist. Dr. Shapiro's areas of interest include anticoagulation in a variety of settings, including venous thromboembolism, stroke prevention for atrial fibrillation, and pregnancy.

Dr Charles E. McPherson is the Clinical Assistant Professor in the Department of Pharmacy Practice at University of Illinois (UIC) College of Pharmacy. Dr. McPherson works as a Clinical Pharmacist in University of Illinois Hospital in the Department of Internal Medicine. Dr. McPherson received his Doctor of Pharmacy degree from the University of Texas at Austin in 1997. His interest areas include: cardiology, infectious diseases, and healthcare disparities.

Dr Kelvin To is the Clinical Assistant Professor at the Department of Microbiology, Carol Yu Centre for Infection, the University of Hong Kong. He received his Bachelor of Science degree in microbiology from the University of British Columbia, Canada, and received his medical training at the University of Hong Kong. He has undergone specialist training at the Department of Microbiology at Queen Mary Hospital, and is now a Fellow of the Royal College of Pathologists of the United Kingdom and a Fellow of the Hong Kong College of Pathologists. His research focuses on emerging infections and antimicrobial resistance of local importance.

Dr Esther Chan is the Assistant Professor in Department of Pharmacology and Pharmacy at the University of Hong Kong. Currently, she is also the Research Lead for the Centre for Safe Medication Practice and Research. Dr Chan teaches clinical pharmacy in the University of Hong Kong. Her research interests include clinical and practice-based research in the emergency setting, pharmacoconomics and medication safety. Dr Chan completed her PhD study on "Improving the management of acute agitation in the emergency setting" at Monash University in Australia in 2011.

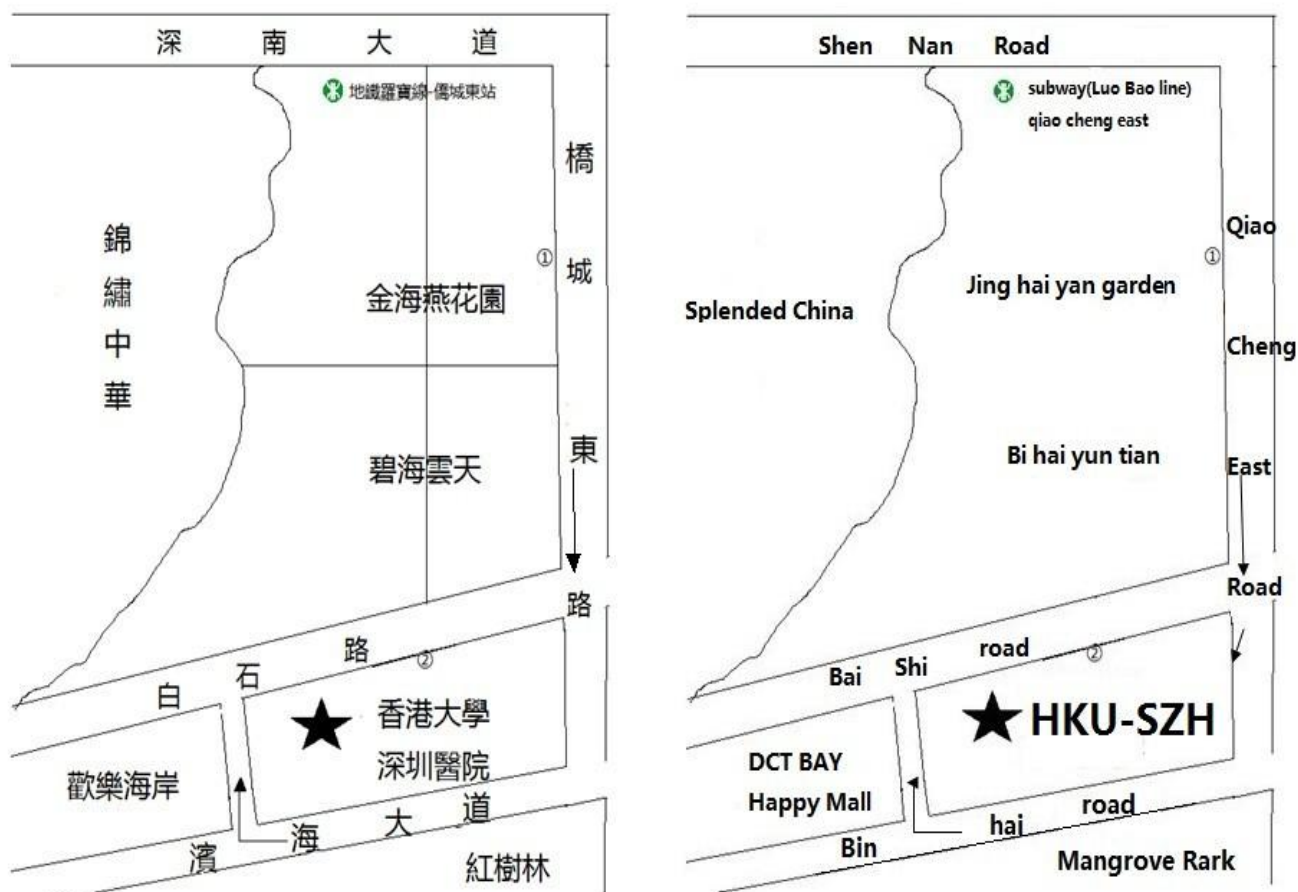

Directions to the Hong Kong University-Shenzhen Hospital

Venue: Lecture Theatre, Hong Kong University-Shenzhen Hospital, Haiyuan No.1 Futian, Shenzhen

Please see the location of the hospital in the map below: It is located at the junction between Baishi Road and Qiaocheng East Road.



Recommended routes:

From Hong Kong to Futian Port: Take Hong Kong KTR to Lok Ma Chau station. After the China Immigration Department, you will reach Futian Port in China. From the Futian port, you can reach HKU-SZH by underground or taxi.

① Free-of-charge pick-up service from Futian port

Our hospital provides vehicles to fetch attendees from Futian Port at 8:30am at no extra cost. Places are limited and there are 15 places available. Please contact Christina either by mobile 69482850 or email (leungyk@hku-szh.org) to reserve a place.

② By underground

From Futian station (Longhua line) → Exhibition Centre station (transfer to Luobao line) → Qiao Cheng East station, exit from B or C1, go by Jinghaiyan Garden or Bihaiyuantian. It is about 700 meters by foot.

③ By taxi

From Futian taxi Station to Hong Kong University-Shenzhen Hospital, the fee is about ¥35 and it takes about 15 mins.
